We are pleased to announce the Fourth International Symposium on the Nuclear Symmetry Energy (NuSYM14), which will be held on July 7-9, 2014 at the University of Liverpool, United Kingdom.

The symposium will cover similar topics to those discussed in past editions, with a particular emphasis on the links with astrophysics:

- Advances in the nuclear equation of state
- Recent theoretical developments related to isospin asymmetric nuclear matter
- New experimental constraints on the symmetry energy from nuclear reactions and nuclear structure experiments
- Symmetry energy and neutron stars from X-ray, radio and gravitational wave observatories

The programme will comprise of invited and contributed talks as well as posters and the participation of young researchers is strongly encouraged. Further details about abstract submission deadlines will be communicated shortly in the second circular.
